Site Escalation

- DO NOT delay activating emergency response, and/ or contacting the MRP
- Notify local clinical supports if available



Identify Reason for the Call

- See back of card
- Gather flowsheet, chart and other applicable documents



Call the Critical Care Outreach Nurse

 24/7 - Nurse or RT calls the BCCH PICU Unit clerk, asks for CCON: 604-875-2133







Reasons to Call CCON

Remember, if you are worried or unsure, that is reason enough to call. Reasons may include and are not limited to:

Patient Assessment

- Level of Consciousness (LOC)
- Vital signs
- Respiratory assessment
- Cardiovascular assessment

Pediatric Protocols/Skills

- Diabetic Ketoacidosis (DKA)
- Asthma
- Croup
- Trauma
- Burns
- Take 5 Check Ins

Medication / Infusions

- Unfamiliar medications
- Weight-based dosing
- Delirium/withdrawal
 - Fluid status
- Med Calculations

Other Concerns

- Sepsis
- Temperature control
- Pediatric skills
- Patient/caregiver concern
 Increasing PEWS
- Increasing PEVVS
 scores
- Unfamiliar equipment or therapy
- Any other clinical concerns

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
